- » 1 hour of CAS can at most cover editing/reviewing 2 long essays (500 words or above) OR 3 short essays (100-300 words) OR 1 resume OR 1 application OR 1 interview
 - ✓ For essays, it's about maximum of 1000 words per hour
 - ✓ If needing to work on essays from start to finish, 1 long essay will take at least 3 hours and 1 short essay will take at least 2 hours

Format:

- » First 5 minutes will be spent on getting to know the student, and then together with the counselor, they will plan how to spend the rest of the time based on what the student brings and what's a priority
 - ✓ Counselor will let the student know how much they can get done realistically

HOW DO I PREPARE FOR PSAT?

The best way to prepare for the PSAT is to take one of our SAT prep programs and to take a few practice PSAT near the test date (B2A provides unlimited practice tests).

PSAT is simply a shorter, and slightly easier, version of the SAT, so studying for SAT will help you ace both SAT and PSAT!

SHOULD I TAKE THE ISEE OR SSAT?

Contact each school's admissions office to find out their policies and preferences. If a particular exam is required by a school, or if a school prefers one exam to the other, the decision is already made for you.

If the school does not have any preference, take an ISEE or SSAT diagnostic test to compare your scores on the two exams!

WHAT IS THE NATIONAL MERIT SCHOLARSHIP?

Juniors across the nation have a chance at becoming a National Merit Scholarship recipient. They must score top 1% of the state on their junior year PSAT.

Students may qualify for up to full 4-year scholarships and can earn various merit scholarships at college they will apply.

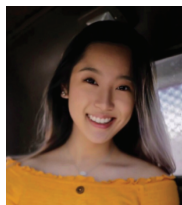

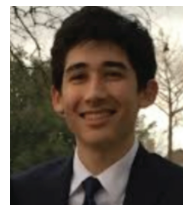

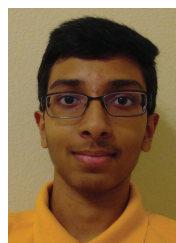
